



## Week 2 [ date] | Creative Common Licenses (CC)

### Context

This week our topic is about a theme that is very important for designing the Digital Storytelling narrative. The amount of information shared on the Internet, including images, audio, video, and other resources, takes on a global dimension. However the use of these resources is done in the right way? Is it possible to share the resources available in the internet? How can we do it? What are the rules? What resources could be used?
